Redemption Road (Landgericht, 2017), Part 1: *Farewell*, TV miniseries in two parts. The miniseries is based on the novel with the same title by Ursula Krechel, and tells the story of a Jewish judge, Richard Kornitzer, who was living in Germany with his family, but the rise of Nazism and WWII destroyed the family. After the war, he fought for justice, but no satisfaction could remedy what his family had suffered. The horrible Nazi crimes left deep wounds, and painful events could not be forgotten. The film, based on a true story, depicts not only events during the war, but also the frequently ignored Germany's post-war history, and thus helps us understand how war, exile and years of alienation affect everyday life and lead to physical and psychological destruction, as they involve the closest and most valuable of human relations: ties between parents and children, and between husband and wife.
