

## SHOAH – LET US REMEMBER, 2024

### Programmes for children and young people

As part of teaching and learning about the Holocaust, preserving the memory of both its victims and other victims of Nazi persecution and raising awareness of the importance of human rights, numerous educational activities will be carried out in Slovenian primary and secondary schools to mark 27 January.

In the 2023/24 school year, Slovenian primary and secondary schools are part of the *Crocus* project led by the Holocaust Education Trust Ireland for the sixth consecutive year. This year's project, dedicated to developing and preserving the memory of the child victims of the Holocaust and Nazi persecution in general, includes 147 Slovenian primary and secondary schools. These items were classified in seven collections. The collection from prisons and camps comprises 1,077 items from German and Italian prisons and camps. As early as 1952, the General Committee of the Red Cross handed over to the then Museum of National Liberation the items of the camp prisoners that had been taken from them on their arrival in the German camps. The Museum also acquired a large amount of material during the preparation of the temporary exhibition <i>The Occupier's Prisons and Camps</i> in 1960.
